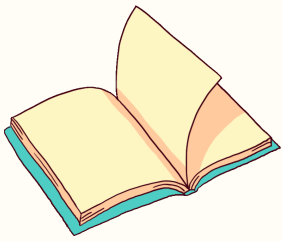

Morning snack

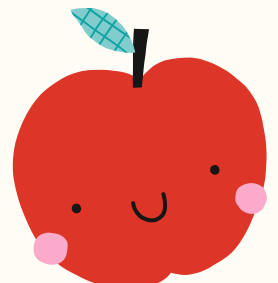
- Your child may bring a small selection of appropriately prepared fruit or

USEFUL REMINDERS

Illnesses

For any illness, please inform us by phone or email, if your child is unable to attend and remember that if your child has vomiting and/or diarrhoea, they must be clear of the symptoms for 48 hours before returning to pre-school. If we have not heard from you by 9.30am we will make contact via email or phone to ensure everything is ok. Remember, if children have had Calpol and/ or have a temperature, they would be better staying at home and returning to pre-school once their symptoms have subsided.

Lunch Reminders:

Please be aware that we DO NOT allow nuts or nut products in the pre-school. If your child has grapes, olives and/ or tomatoes in their lunch (all lovely additions), it is a good idea to cut these in half lengthways.

Naming Items:

Please make sure that all of your child's items are clearly labelled with their names. This includes, please, Lunchboxes, water bottles as well as items of clothing.

Up to Date Information:

It is important that we have the most up to date information for families. Please inform us of any changes to medical conditions, addresses, or contact details.

Funding and 30 hours entitlement
